Thank you for your patience, and thank you for reaching out again. I appreciate you sharing the details of your work and your ongoing proceedings before the National Privacy Commission.

I appreciate you taking the time to introduce your case and the goals behind your advocacy. We also appreciate your interest in People Over Platforms Worldwide and the work we are doing to support individuals affected by wrongful platform enforcement.

In response to your request, we have reviewed our records and can confirm that approximately 2,183 verified supporters in our global petition database are from the Philippines. The overwhelming majority of reports submitted through our campaign relate to Meta account suspensions and enforcement actions.

This figure is provided as an aggregate statistic only. We do not disclose any personally identifiable information or supporter-level data in order to protect the privacy of those who have entrusted us with their information.

Thank you very much for your swift response and for extracting these critical database metrics.

The aggregate figure of **2,183 verified supporters within the Philippines**—coupled with your confirmation that the overwhelming majority relate strictly to Meta account actions—is an immense asset to our legal track. It fundamentally shifts our position before the National Privacy Commission (NPC) En Banc. This data turns an individual infrastructure dispute into an unassailable demonstration of systemic, jurisdiction-wide algorithmic failure.

In alignment with our commitment to open-source platform accountability, I have officially updated our public tracking ledger at **www.case001.org** to document this milestone. The top of the ledger now features an open institutional challenge to the regulators and local press, backed directly by your verified 2,183 metric.

Per your privacy protocols, this data is hosted purely as an aggregate statistical fact to protect individual supporter anonymity. To further drive public awareness of the human cost, I am also manually curating public testimonies from your open supporter comments feed to feature as a rotating alert on our main page.

We will continue to aggressively push the envelope before the state tribunal to force a metadata subpoena. I look forward to keeping you and the People Over Platforms community fully updated as the server logs move into formal regulatory review.
